

# NEBOSH HSE Certificate in Health and Safety Leadership Excellence



## BE THE LEADER TO INFLUENCE HEALTH AND SAFETY PERFORMANCE AND CULTURE

### Course Overview

This one-day qualification is a joint collaboration between NEBOSH and UK's Health and Safety Regulator, the Health and Safety Executive (HSE). It is designed for senior business leaders or aspiring leaders who wish to improve their capability in health and safety leadership.

It highlights the moral, legal and financial reasons for good health and safety leadership. It offers guidance on the key areas to focus on to make a difference and how leaders can become better advocates and influencers in relation to health and safety; which will directly impact on the health and safety performance and culture in their workplace.

### Who should attend

This course is for current and future senior business leaders who are responsible for their organisations' health and safety leadership; or anyone involved in the health and well-being of employees as part of his/her day-to-day duties.

### Course outline

- What health and safety leadership means
- The moral, legal and financial reasons for good health and safety leadership
- The links between health and safety leadership and culture
- What are the different leadership styles
- How human failures can impact performance and culture
- The HSE's model of effective health and safety leadership
- How leaders can build effective relationships with the workforce

### Course Duration & Study modes

Full-time – One day classroom learning (3 hours pre-course study prior to attending the class).

## Qualification Structure

The Certificate in Health and Safety Leadership Excellence is made up of one unit:

### Unit HSL1: Health and safety leadership

- Unit HSL1 is a taught unit, assessed by an on the day assessment which includes a leadership intervention that the participant is planning to undertake.

## Assessment and Certification

The assessment will be in the form of reflective statements undertaken throughout the course. These show how the participant's knowledge, skill and behaviours may have both positive and negative effects on health and safety performance in their organisation.

Participants will also need to make a commitment to a leadership intervention that will improve health and safety management within their sphere of influence at work.

Participants must achieve a 'Pass' in Unit HSL1 to pass the qualification and will be awarded with NEBOSH HSE Certificate in Health and Safety Leadership Excellence certificate issued by NEBOSH.

## SQA Accreditation

The NEBOSH HSE Certificate in Health and Safety Leadership Excellence is intended to be rated within Scottish Credit and Qualifications Framework (SCQF) at SCQF Level 6 with 1 SCQF credit point. SCQF Level 6 is comparable to NQF/QCF Level 3 in England, Wales and Northern Ireland.
