Course Overview

This two day course is an entrant course to introduce delegates the essential knowledge regards to confined space entry and rescue.

What are the benefits?

- Identify the relevant legislation covering confined spaces.
- State the potential hazards of working in confined spaces and the precautionary measures to be used.
- Describe the Safe Systems of Work, Permit to Work and Risk Assessment procedures.
- Explain atmospheric testing (i.e. for gas)
- Describe the emergency procedures relevant to the confined space activities.
- Explain the techniques of basic life support.
- Identify and use the correct respiratory and protective equipment.
- Demonstrate the correct techniques when entering and leaving a confined space, including the correct use of any equipment.

Who should attend?

All personnel who are required to enter a confined space during at work.

Course Duration

Delegates will need to complete a 2 day full time training (theory & walk-through practical).

Assessment & Certification

Delegates will be assessed by a multiple-choice exam with practical assignment at the end of the course. Upon successful course completion, delegates will be awarded with KBA Training Centre certificate of training.
